

Insulting Companions exits one from fold of Islaam

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

Question: "I know an individual who used to be upon the methodology of Ahlus Sunnah wal Jama'ah, he then after that came to be upon the creed of the Raafidah and is insulting the Companions. Does he exit from the fold of Islaam?"

Shaykh Saalih bin Fawzaan al-Fawzaan [May Allaah preserve him]: "Yes. If he commits a nullifier from the nullifiers of Islaam, he exits from Islaam. Insulting the Companions and hating them, this proves the disbelief.

[...that He may enrage the disbelievers with them.]

Allaah the Majestic and Most High says when mentioning the companions at the end of Soorah al-Fath:

[...that He may enrage the disbelievers with them.]¹

Therefore the one who insults them out of hatred and hostility towards them; this is a proof for his disbelief. Yes."
