

Ruling of invitation to Raafidah weddings and their meat

Shaykh Saalih bin Fawzaan al-Fawzaan [May Allaah preserve him]

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بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

Question: “May Allaah be good to you. The questioner says: What is the ruling of accepting the invitation of the Raafidah (Shia) to weddings? And is their slaughter (i.e. the meat from animals slaughtered by them) lawful?”

Shaykh Saalih bin Fawzaan al-Fawzaan [May Allaah preserve him]: “Their slaughter, no. As for their invitation; if it is hoped that they repent and that they... this is from getting them to repent. Or that they are neighbours, the neighbour still has his right, if they are neighbours he invites them. Yes.”

السؤال: ما حكم قبول دعوة الروافض للأعراس؟ وهل تحل ذبحتهم؟

الجواب: ذبحتهم لا، أما دعوتهم إذا كان يرجى إنهم يتوبون هذا من تأليفهم للتوبة، أو إنهم جيران، الجار له حق بعد، إذا كانوا جيران يدعوهم.
