Advice for whose parents commit aspects of polytheism

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

Question: Some Muslim brothers have problems with their parents because of their committing Shirk (polytheism) and not accepting their advice. What would you advise them to do? Great troubles have occurred between those Muslim brothers and their parents.

Shaykh Aboo `Abd-al-Mu`iz `Alee Farkous al-Qoobee (May Allaah the Most High preserve him): All praise is due to Allaah, the Lord of the Worlds. Peace and blessing be upon whom Allaah sent as a mercy to the Worlds, upon his Family, his Companions and his Brothers till the Day of Resurrection.

They should direct them and call them to Allaah (*Mighty and Majestic is He*), and they should not leave them, but should behave with them in the world with kindness as the verse states:

(وَإِنْ جَاهَدَاكَ عَلَى أَنْ تُشْرِكَ بِي مَا لَيْسَ لَكَ بِهِ عِلْمٌ فَلاَ تُطِعْهُمَا وَصَاحِبْهُمَا فِي الدُّنْيَا مَعْرُوفًا)
[But if they (both) strive with you to make you join in worship with Me others that of which you have no knowledge, then, obey them not; but behave with them in the world kindly11

They should also invite them to religion kindly; avoid coarseness and repelling hardness as Allaah (*Mighty and Majestic is He*) said:

[Invite (mankind, O Muhammad (May the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him)) to the Way of your Lord (i.e. Islaam) and wisdom (i.e. with the Divine Revelation and the Qur'aan) and fair preaching, and argue with them in a way that is better]²

In fact, this followed way of calling (to Allaah) is one of the most important reasons of benefiting the common people with the callers' invitation, guidance and directions. The Prophet (May the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) already said:

"If Allaah guides a single person to embrace Islaam at your hand (i.e. through you) that will be better for you than the red camels"³.
