

Beneficial Dua's from the Sunnah – 1

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بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ (مائة مرة)

The Messenger of Allaah (may the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said, **Whoever says: "How far from imperfections Allaah is and I praise Him." (100 Times) ...a hundred times during the day, his sins are wiped away, even if they are like the foam of the sea.**

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ ، وَسُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ الْعَظِيمِ

Abou Hurairah (may Allaah be pleased with him) reported that the Messenger of Allaah (may the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: **(There are) Two words, (which are) light on the tongue, heavy on the Scale and beloved to The Most Gracious, "How far from imperfections Allaah is and I praise Him. How far from imperfections Allaah is, The Supreme."**

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ الْعَظِيمِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ

Jabir (may Allaah be pleased with him) related that the Prophet (may the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: **Whoever says, "How far from imperfections Allaah is. The Supreme, and I praise Him." ...a palm tree is planted for him in paradise.**

Abou Ayyoob al-Ansaaree (may Allaah be pleased with him) related that the Prophet (may the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: **Whoever says: "None has the right to be worshipped except Allaah, alone, without partner. To Him belongs all sovereignty and praise and He is over all things omnipotent." ...ten times, is like the one who has freed four souls from among the children of Ismaaa'eel.**

Sa'ad (may Allaah be pleased with him) said: We were sitting with the Messenger of Allaah (may the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) and he said, **"Is any one of you unable to gain a thousand good deeds each day?"** Somebody then asked him (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him), **"How does one achieve a thousand good deeds?"** He (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) replied, **"He should say, 'How far from imperfections Allaah is.' ...one hundred times, for a thousand good deeds are recorded for him or a thousand bad deeds are wiped away."**

| <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Dua when visiting the graves</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ أَهْلَ الدِّيَارِ مِنَ الْمُؤْمِنِينَ وَالْمُسْلِمِينَ ، وَإِنَّا إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ بِكُمْ لَلْآحِقُونَ ، نَسْأَلُ اللَّهَ لَنَا وَلَكُمْ الْعَافِيَةَ</p> <p style="text-align: center;">"Peace be upon you all, O inhabitants of the dwellings (i.e. the graves), amongst the believers and the Muslims. Indeed we are, Allaah willing, soon to follow (to die also), we ask Allaah for well-being for us and for you." Note: * The term (Muslims) here means all Muslims whether they are righteous or evildoers, while believers or Mu'min only indicates to the righteous only among the Muslims.
