

## The conditions for an action to be correct – Condition 3

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

With regards to the conditions for an action to be correct, the Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al 'Uthaymeen (رَجْمَةُ اللَّهِ)<sup>1</sup> states:

Thirdly – that the action conform to the Sharee'ah in amount. So if a person were to seek to worship Allaah, the Mighty and Majestic, with an amount greater than (that in) the Sharee'ah, it would not be accepted from him.

And an example of that: a man makes wudhoo (ritual ablution) four times i.e. he washes each limb four times. So the fourth (time) would not be accepted because it is in excess of that which the Sharee'ah came with.

Rather it has come in the hadeeth that the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم)<sup>2</sup> made wudhoo with three (washes).
