

## Correct method for calling non-Muslims to Islaam

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

**Question:** "What is the correct method for calling non-Muslims to Islaam and who are responsible for calling the Kuffaar (disbelievers) in the West to Islaam?"

**Shaykh Muhammad bin 'Abdullaah as-Subayyal:** "Each Muslim should take this responsibility upon himself to discharge this risaalah or this message of Islaam to the people. Each Muslim should invite according his ability. Each person should at least have some knowledge about what he is inviting to, so that he can actually call in a way that is convincing and there should be no harshness or violence involved in inviting to the Deen. Allaah [(Subhanahu wa-ta'ala) The Exalted, The Most High] says:

**[Invite (mankind, O Muhammad [(sallallaahu 'alayhi wa sallam) May the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him]) to the way of your Lord (i.e. Islaam) with wisdom (i.e. with the Divine Revelation and the Qur'aan) and fair preaching...]<sup>1</sup>**

So this should be the methodology to be followed – a proper and gentle message implemented by each person who intends to invite, and he should have some knowledge. For this reason the Students of Knowledge, should fulfil this particular responsibility more than anyone else and they should not act arrogantly towards anyone when inviting to Allaah's Deen."
