In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

An easy way to keep devils out of your house by reciting two blessed, ancient verses

An-Nu'maan ibn Basheer narrated that the Prophet [(sallallahu 'alayhi wa sallam) May the peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him] said,

“Indeed Allaah wrote a Book two thousand years before He created the heavens and the earth, He sent down two aayahs from it with which He ended Soorah al-Baqarah—if they are recited for three nights in a home, no Shaitaan shall come near it.”¹

The two verses are:

أَمَّنَ الرَّسُولُ بِمَا أُنزِلَ إِلَيْهِ مِنْ رَبِّهِ وَالْمُؤْمِنُونَ كُلٌّ آمَنَ بِاللَّهِ وَمَلَائِكَتِهِ وَكُتُبِهِ وَرُسُلِهِ لَا نُفَرِّقُ
بَيْنَ أَحَدٍ مِنْ رُسُلِهِ وَقَالُوا سَمِعْنَا وَأَطَعْنَا غُفْرَانَكَ رَبَّنَا وَإِلَيْكَ الْمَصِيرُ

'Āmanar-Rasoolu bimaa 'unzila 'ilayhi mir-rabbihi wal-Mu'uminoona kullun 'Aamana billaahi wa Malaa'ikatihi wa Kutubihi wa Rusulihi Laa nufarriq baina 'ahhadin mir-Rusulihi wa qaloo sami`naa wa 'Aṭa`naa Ghufraanaka Rabbanaa wa 'ilaikal-Maṣeer.

["The Messenger believes in what has been sent down to him from his Lord, and (so do) the believers. Each one believes in Allaah, His Angels, His Books, and His Messengers. They say, “We make no distinction between one another of His Messengers.” And they say, “We hear, and we obey. (We seek) Your Forgiveness, Our Lord, and to You is the return (of all).”]²

Laa yukallifullaahu nafsan 'illaa wus`ahaa Lahaa maa kasabat wa `alaihā maktasabat Rabbanaa laa tu'uaakhidhnaa 'in-naseenaa 'aw 'akhṭa'naa Rabbanaa wa laa taḥmil `alainaa 'iṣran kamaa ḥamaltahu `alalladheena min qablinaa Rabbanaa wa laa tuḥammilnaa maa laa ṭaaqata lanaa bihi Wa`fu `annaa waghfir lanaa warḥamnaa 'Anta mawlaanaa faanṣurnaa `alal-qawmil-kaafireen.

["Allaah burdens not a person beyond his scope. He gets reward for that (good) which he has earned, and he is punished for that (evil) which he has earned. "Our Lord! Punish us not if we forget or fall into error. Our Lord! Lay not on us a burden like that which You did lay on those before us. Our Lord! Put not on us a burden greater than we have strength to bear. Pardon us and grant us Forgiveness. Have mercy on us. You are our Protector! And give us victory over the disbelieving people.""]³
