### Question:

One of my Non-Muslim workers has converted to Islam. A few hours later, he asked for a Mus\_haf<sup>1</sup> and a translation to read. After a few days, he asked to go and perform `Umrah (lesser pilgrimage). My question is: Should I let him touch the Mus\_haf and travel to Allaah's Sacred Land, or wait a year or more until he becomes a true Muslim, and I am sure that has sincerely embraced Islam?

### Answer:

If you are sure concerning his Islam, it is permissible for you to give him a Mus\_haf to read and accompany him to perform Hajj or `Umrah. You will be rewarded for this Insha'allaah, for the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وسلم)<sup>2</sup> stated: **"Whoever calls others to follow guidance, their reward will be equivalent to those who shall follow them (in righteousness)"** And Allaah helps His servant as long as the servant helps their fellow brothers.

May Allaah grant us success! May peace and blessings be upon our Prophet Muhammad, his family, and Companions!
