


One who leaves off all actions is a disbeliever

Questioner: "As salamu 'alaykum wa rahmatullahi wa barakatuh."

Shaykh: "Wa 'alaykum salam wa rahmatullahi wa barakatuh."

Questioner: "Shaykh Ahmad an-Najmee? HayakAllaah."

Shaykh: "May Allaah protect you."

Questioner: "Oh Shaykh, I have a question, may Allaah bless you."

Muslim, then he is liar. He cannot be a Muslim unless he performs actions."

Shavkh: "And you to."
