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# Sins

#### بِسْمِراًللهِ ٱلرَّحْمَنِ ٱلرَّحِيمِ

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

• Al-Hasan al-Basree (May Allaah have mercy on him) said:

#### "Verily, a man commits a sin and never forgets it and he won't cease to be afraid of it until he enters Paradise."<sup>1</sup>

• Ibn al-Qayyim (May Allaah have mercy on him) said:

"No slave of Allaah commits a sin except that a blessing from Allaah is removed from him equal to that sin."<sup>2</sup>

• Sufyaan Ibn 'Uyaynah (d.198H) (*May Allaah have mercy on him*) said:

"He whose sin is due to desire, then have hope for him; and he whose sin is due to pride, then fear for him. Because Aadam (*Peace be upon him*) sinned due to desire, and he was forgiven; and Iblees sinned due to pride, and he was cursed."<sup>3</sup>

• Ibn al-Qayyim (May Allaah have mercy on him) said: Some of the Salaf said:

"I committed one sin and due to it, I was prevented from Qiyaam al-Layl one year"<sup>4</sup>

• Ibn Mas'ood (May Allaah be pleased with him) said:

"Indeed, I consider that the man forgets the knowledge which he knew he has because of the sin he commits"<sup>5</sup>

• Ibn al-Qayyim (*May Allaah have mercy on him*) said:

#### "If you sin it will create a defect in you that may never be removed."<sup>6</sup>

• Ibn al-Qayyim (May Allaah have mercy on him) said:

"Enough as a punishment for sins is that it prevents you from worshipping Allaah, even if you wanted to."<sup>7</sup>

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• Ibn Taymeeyyah (*May Allaah have mercy on him*) said:

#### "Sins make the face ugly."<sup>8</sup>

• Ibn al-Qayyim (May Allaah have mercy on him) said:

#### "Sins are wounds and one wound may cause death."9

• Ibn al-Qayyim (May Allaah have mercy on him) said:

#### "Man almost forgets the knowledge he has gained because of the sins he has committed."<sup>10</sup>

• Ibn Taymeeyyah (May Allaah have mercy on him) said:

#### "Sins cause harm and repentance removes the cause."<sup>11</sup>

• The Salaf used to say:

### "Sins lead to kufr, kisses to intercourse, songs to Zina, a sight to falling in love, and a disease to death."<sup>12</sup>

• Ee'sa Ibn Maryam (Peace be upon him) said:

#### "Indeed whoever prays and fasts, but does not leave off sinning, then it is written that he is a liar."<sup>13</sup>

• Ibn al-Qayyim (May Allaah have mercy on him) said:

"Sins have many side effects. One of them is that they steal knowledge from you."<sup>14</sup>
