918. Aboo Sa'eed Al-Khudree (May Allaah be pleased with him) reported: The Messenger of Allaah (sallallaahu alayhi wa sallam) Said, "Exhort your dying men to recite: 'La ilaha illallah' (There is no true God except Allaah)."²
