Beginning of Ramadhaan

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

When the month of Ramadhaan begins, the gates of the heaven are opened, the gates of Hellfire are closed, and the devils are chained.¹

Talhah ibn 'Ubayd reported: Whenever the Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, saw the crescent moon, he would say:

O Allaah, bring it over us with blessings and faith, safety and Islaam. My Lord and your Lord is

Allaah.²

In another narration, the Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

اللَّهُمَّ أَهِلَّهُ عَلَيْنَا بِالْأَمْنِ وَالْإِيمَانِ وَالسَّلَامَةِ وَالْإِسْلَامِ وَالتَّوْفِيقِ لِمَا تُحِبُّ وَتَرْضَى رَبُّنَا وَرَبُّكَ اللَّهُ O Allaah, bring it over us with safety and faith, security and Islaam, guidance to what You love and is pleasing to You. Our Lord and your Lord is Allaah.³

Anas ibn Maalik reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said when the month of Ramadhaan began:

Verily, this month has presented itself to you. There is a night within it that is better than a thousand months. Whoever is deprived of it has been deprived of all good. None is deprived of its good but that he is truly deprived.⁴

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said when the month of Ramadhaan arrived:

The month of Ramadhaan has come, a blessed month in which Allaah Almighty has obligated you to fast. In it the gates of the heavens are opened, the gates of Hellfire are closed, the devils are chained, and in it is a night that is better than a thousand months. Thus, whoever is deprived of its good is truly deprived.⁵

In another narration, the Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

On the first night of the month of Ramadhaan, the devils are chained and the jinn are restrained, the gates of Hellfire are closed and none of its gates are opened, the gates of Paradise are opened and none of its gates are closed, and a heavenly caller announces: O seeker of good, come near! O seeker of evil, stop short! Allaah has those He saves from the Hellfire, and that is during every night. 6

Greatness of Ramadhaan

Ibn Umar reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Islaam is built upon five: to worship Allaah and to disbelieve in what is worshiped besides him, to establish prayer, to give charity, to perform Hajj pilgrimage to the house, and to fast the month of Ramadhaan.⁷

Aboo Hurairah reported: A Bedouin came to the Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, and he said, "O Messenger of Allaah, show me a deed by which I may enter Paradise." The Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

The man said, "By Him in whose hand is my soul, I will never add anything to it, nor will I lessen anything from it." When the man turned his back, the Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Whoever is pleased to see a man from the people of Paradise, let him look at this one.8

'Amr ibn Murrah reported: A man came to the Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, and he said, "O Messenger of Allaah, what do you think if I testify there is no God but Allaah and you are the Messenger of Allaah, I perform the five prayers, I pay the obligatory alms, I fast the month of Ramadhaan and stand for prayer in it. Among whom will I be?" The Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

مِنَ الصِّدِّيقِينَ وَ الشُّهَدَاءِ مِنَ الصِّدِّيقِينَ وَ الشُّهَدَاءِ Among the truthful and the martyrs.⁹

Aboo Hurairah reported: There were two men from the tribe of Quda'ah who embraced Islaam with the Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him. One of them was martyred and the other lived for another year. Talhah said, "I had a dream of Paradise and I saw the one who lived longer enter Paradise before the martyr. I was amazed by that and when I woke up, I mentioned it to the Prophet." The Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Did he not fast the month of Ramadhaan after him? And he performed six thousand or so bowings in prayer throughout the year?¹⁰

Aboo al-Muntafiq reported: I said, "O Messenger of Allaah, teach me what will save me from the punishment of Allaah and admit me into Paradise." The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Worship Allaah and do not associate anything with Him, establish the prescribed prayers, give the obligatory charity, perform the Hajj and 'Umrah pilgrimages, and fast the month of Ramadhaan.

Look at the way you would love people to treat you and do so to them, and whatever you would hate for them to do to you, spare them of it. 11

Aboo Umamah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said in his farewell sermon:

اتَّقُوا اللَّهَ رَبَّكُمْ وَصَلُّوا خَمْسَكُمْ وَصَنُومُوا شَهْرَكُمْ وَأَدُّوا زَكَاةَ أَمْوَالِكُمْ وَأَطِيعُوا ذَا أَمْرِكُمْ تَدْخُلُوا جَنَّةَ رَبِّكُمْ Fear Allaah your Lord, pray your five prayers, fast your month of Ramadhaan, give charity from your wealth, and obey those in authority over you. You will enter the Paradise of your Lord. 12

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

If a woman prays her five prayers, fasts her month of Ramadhaan, guards her chastity, and obeys her husband, she will enter Paradise from any gate she wishes. ¹³

Aboo Darda reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Whoever comes with five deeds, along with faith, will enter Paradise: one who preserves the five prayers, their ablution, their bowings, their prostrations, and their timings, who fasts the month of Ramadhaan, who performs Hajj pilgrimage to the House if he can find the means, who gives charity with a cheerful soul, and one who fulfils the trust.¹⁴

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Islaam is to worship Allaah without associating a partner with Him, to establish prayer, to give charity, to fast the month of Ramadhaan, to perform pilgrimage to the House, to enjoin good and forbid evil, and to greet your people with peace. Whoever neglects anything from them has abandoned a part of Islaam, and whoever neglects all of them has thrown Islaam behind his hack. 15

Forgiveness and Reward in Ramadhaan

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

الصَّلَوَ اتُ الْخَمْسُ وَ الْجُمُعَةُ الِّي الْجُمُعَةِ وَرَ مَضِيَانُ الِّي رَ مَضِيَانَ مُكَفِّرَ اتُّ مَا يَبْنَهُنَّ مَا اجْتُنِيَتْ الْكَيَائِرُ The five prayers, Friday to Friday, and Ramadhaan to Ramadhaan will be expiation for the sins between them, so long as major sins are avoided. 16

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Whoever fasts the month of Ramadhaan due to faith and seeking reward, his previous sins will be forgiven. Whoever stands in prayer during the Night of Decree due to faith and seeking reward, his previous sins will be forgiven. 17

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, encouraged standing for night prayer in the month of Ramadhaan, without imposing it on them. The Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, would say:

Whoever stands in prayer during Ramadhaan due to faith and seeking reward, his previous sins will be forgiven. 18

Aboo Sa'eed al-Khudree reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Abdur-Rahmaan ibn Awf reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Verily, Ramadhaan is a month in which Allaah Almighty has obligated its fasting. I have instituted for Muslims the practice of prayer at night. Thus, whoever fasts it with faith and expecting reward will be rid of sins like the day he was born from his mother.²⁰

Aboo Sa'eed al-Khudree reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Verily, Allaah has people He redeems in every day and night of Ramadhaan, and every servant among them has a supplication that will be answered.²¹

Aboo Dharr reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Verily, whoever stands for prayer in Ramadhaan with the Imaam until he is finished, it will be recorded as if he prayed the entire night.²²

Ibn Abbaas reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Verily, the 'Umrah pilgrimage during Ramadhaan is equal to Hajj. 23

Reciting the Qur'aan in Ramadhaan

Ibn Abbaas, may Allaah be pleased with him, Said:

The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, was the most generous of people and he was even more generous in Ramadhaan when Gabriel would meet him. He would meet him every night of Ramadhaan to study the Qur'aan. Thus, the Prophet would be more generous than a nourishing wind.²⁴

Fatimah, may Allaah be pleased with her, reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Gabriel would come to me to revise the Qur'aan once every year. This year he revised with me twice. I do not think it means anything but that my term will come to an end.²⁵

Aboo Hurairah, may Allaah be pleased with him, said:

The Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, would review the Qur'aan once every year in Ramadhaan, and he reviewed it twice in the year he passed away. The Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, would retreat in the mosque for ten days every year, and he secluded himself for twenty days in the year he passed away.²⁶

'A'ishah, may Allaah be pleased with her, said:

I have not known the Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, to read the entire Qur'aan in a single night, nor to spend the whole night in prayer until the morning, nor to spend an entire month in fasting, except during the month of Ramadhaan.²⁷

Wathila ibn al-Asqa' reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

The scriptures of Abraham, upon him be peace, were revealed on the first night of Ramadhaan. The Torah was revealed after six nights of Ramadhaan had passed, the Gospel was revealed after thirteen nights of Ramadhaan had passed, and the Qur'aan was revealed after twenty-four nights of Ramadhaan had passed.²⁸

Safeguarding the Fast

Anas ibn Maalik reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Take the pre-fasting meal, for surely there are blessings in the pre-fasting meal.²⁹

Al-'Irbaad ibn Sariyah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, invited me to the pre-fasting meal during Ramadhaan and he said:

Onward to the blessed meal! 30

Sahl ibn Sa'd reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

People will continue in goodness as long as they hasten to break their fast.³¹

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Whoever does not leave evil words and deeds while fasting, Allaah does not need him to leave food and drink.³²

In another narration, the Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

When one of you wakes up in the morning for fasting, then he should not use obscene language or behave foolishly. If anyone abuses him or fights with him, he should say twice: Indeed, I am fasting.³³

And in another narration, the Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Verily, fasting is not only from eating and drinking. Rather, fasting is from vanity and obscenity. If someone abuses you or acts foolish against you, then say: Indeed, I am fasting.³⁴

And in another narration, the Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Do not insult anyone while you are fasting. If anyone insults you, then say: Indeed, I am fasting. If you are standing, then sit down.³⁵

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, ascended the pulpit and he said:

Ameen, ameen, ameen.

It was said, "O Messenger of Allaah, you ascended the pulpit and said ameen, ameen, ameen." The Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Verily, Gabriel came to me and he said: Whoever reaches the month of Ramadhaan and he is not forgiven, then he will enter Hellfire and Allaah will cast him far away, so say ameen. I said ameen. Whoever sees his parents in their old age, one or both of them, and he does not honour them and he dies, then he will enter Hellfire and Allaah will cast him far away, so say ameen. I said ameen. Whoever has your name mentioned in his presence and he does not send blessings upon you and he dies, then he will enter Hellfire and Allaah will cast him far away, so say ameen. I said ameen. ³⁶

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

May he be humbled, who enters the month of Ramadhaan and it passes before he is forgiven. ³⁷

Aboo Hurairah reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Whoever eats or drinks forgetfully while he is fasting, let him complete his fast, for Allaah has fed him and given him drink.³⁸

In another narration, the Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Whoever breaks his fast forgetfully in the month of Ramadhaan, there is no compensation or expiation for it. ³⁹

Aboo Hurairah reported: A man came to the Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, and he said, "I am ruined, O Messenger of Allaah!" The Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

The man said, "I was intimate with my wife during Ramadhaan." The Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

The man said no. The Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Verily, I have come out to tell you about the Night of Decree, but two men were insulting each other. Thus, its knowledge was taken away and perhaps it is better for you. Look for it during the seventh, ninth, or fifth night of the last ten nights. 41

Ibn Umar reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

'A'ishah reported: I said, "O Messenger of Allaah, if I know which night is the Night of Decree, what should I say during it?" The Prophet peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Retreat (al-'Itikaf)

Ibn Umar, may Allaah be pleased with him, said:

The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, would retreat to the mosque in the last ten nights of Ramadhaan.⁴⁵

Aisha, may Allaah be pleased with her, Said:

When the last ten days of Ramadhaan arrived, the Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, would tighten his belt, spend the night in worship, and awaken his family.⁴⁶

In another narration, Aisha said:

The Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, would exert himself in worship during the last ten nights of Ramadhaan more so than any other time.⁴⁷

End of Ramadhaan Charity (Zakaat al-Fitr)

Ibn Umar, may Allaah be pleased with him, said:

The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, made it an obligation to pay charity at the end of Ramadhaan, a portion of dates or barely, upon the slave and the freeman, the male and female, the young and the old among the Muslims. The Prophet ordered it to be given before people go out for the 'Eed prayer.⁴⁸

Ibn Abbaas, may Allaah be pleased with him, said:

The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, obligated charity at the end of Ramadhaan as purification of the fasting person from vain talk and misbehaviour, as food for the poor. Whoever pays it before the 'Eed prayer, it is accepted as Zakaat. Whoever pays it after the 'Eed prayer, it is part of voluntary charity.⁴⁹

Fasting After Ramadhaan

Aboo Ayoob reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

Whoever fasts the month of Ramadhaan and then follows it with six days of fasting in the month of Shawwal, it will be as if he fasted for the entire year.⁵⁰

Thawban reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said:

ing the month of Ramadhaan is like ten months of fasting and fasting six days of Shawwa like two months of fasting. Thus, they are like fasting for a year.⁵¹
